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AN EVALUATION OF HOMOEOPATHIC DRUG:CALCAREA ARSENICOSA, WITH REVIEW OF RELATED LITERATURE

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ABSTRACT:

Calcarea arsenicum is the remedy which is prepared by mixing Calcarea & Arsenic components. This concept leads to the development of symptoms that are similar to Calcarea Carbonicum and Arsenic Album. Therefore, the proving of this remedy was done by Dr. Constantine Hering who played a significant role in development and explanation of homeopathy by providing it on his own body. This remedy has marked effects on fleshy women who are approaching menopause and have a malignant tendency. It also works well on drunkards, who have a strong craving for alcohol after abstaining from it. Hence this remedy was made to address a broader spectrum of symptoms and to elevate strengths of both parent substances. Moreover, this analysis will be based on most relevant symptoms which were produced during drug proving by different authors.

INTRODUCTION: CALCIUM GROUP:

Definition:

Calcium is one of the very important earth alkalizes placed in IIA position in the periodic table. The name calcium was derived from the Latin word "calx" (lime). Davy was the first to prepare the metal by electrolytic method in 1808. The pure metal was obtained by Moissan in 1898 by reduction of calcium iodide with metallic sodium.

Properties of Calcium:

- 1. It is silvery white metal, which is malleable and hard.
- 2. In moist air it is slowly tarnished but decomposes water fairly, rapidly giving hydrogen.
- 3. It burns in air forming oxides.
- 4. It has great affinity towards oxygen.

Uses of Calcium:

- 1. Used as a drying agent in the preparation of alcohol.
- 2. For absorbing air from castings.
- 3. For removing last traces of air from noble gases and to obtain higher vacuum.



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- 4. For removal of Sulphur from petroleum.
- 5. For the preparation of beryllium, chromium, thorium by the reduction of their oxides.
- 6. For removal of last traces of dissolved oxygen, nitrogen and Sulphur from the metals during their extraction.

Biochemical Uses:

Ionized calcium in plasma has many vital functions including formation of

- 1. Bones and teeth.
- 2. Coagulation of blood.
- 3. Contracted of muscles
- 4. Cardiac action
- 5. Milk production
- 6. Relay of electrical and chemical messages that arrive at cell's surface membrane.
- 7. Keeping the membrane of the cell intact.
- 8. In the membrane of enzymes and hormones.
- 9. Transformation of light to electrical impulses in the retina.

Distribution:

Calcium is major element of body. It constitutes 1.5-2% of the body wt. Of an adult human. An average adult body contains about 1200 gm of calcium of which 98% is found in bone.

Source of Calcium:

Calcium occurs in nature only in combined state as

- 1. Carbonate i.e. as CaCo3 in limestone, ice land spar, marble and chalk, as CaCo3.MgCo3 in dolomite.
- 2. Sulphate e.g. gypsum, CaSo4
- 3. Fluoride Ca3 (po4) 3F.
- 4. Phosphate Ca3 (PO4) 2
- 5. Silicate CaSiO3
- 6. Chloride Ca5 (Po4) 3Cl.

Plant source:

- 1. Ragi is the richest source of Ca.
- 2. Legumes and pulses.
- 3. Nuts and oilseeds
- 4. Cereals and millets.
- 5. Green leafy vegetables e.g. Spinach, amaranth.
- 6. Dry fruits, black current, dry dates.

Animal source:

- 1. Milk and milk products: cheese, chocolates milk, ice cream, curds and cream.
- 2. Eggs-egg yolks.
- 3. Fish- Hilda, shellfish, oysters.

Theme of calcarea group:

1. The main feeling of calcarea is the need for stability and security. Calcium offers protection not only to humans in the form of bone but also in earlier forms of life in the form of shell.

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- 2. Calcium is like a young child who releases the instability in the outer world so feels the need for the security of a home.
- 3. Calcium and magnesium have emotional insecurity at their core, but the cause of insecurity is different.
- 4. The Calcium emotional insecurity is because of overprotective background, the Child feels insecure to take a risk, unable to take his own decisions.

Patho-Physiology:

- 1. Calcium must be maintained in normal proportion with different ions in the plasma like Na: K: Ca: Mg, which are in the ratio of 100:1.7:1.1:0.5.
- 2. Free calcium ions are very important in regulation of neuromuscular irritability and hormonal control. It regulates Acetylcholine.
- 3. Calcium action is parasympathetic more than sympathetic.
- 4. Calcium and phosphate ions precipitate an insoluble substance that favours calcification of cartilage into bone formation. Calcium ions stimulate parietal cells of the stomach, which secret HCL. Therefore, though calcium being an alkaline earth metal, it is not used as an antacid in treatment of peptic ulcer. Calcium activates number of enzymes including pancreatic lipase, adenosine triphosphatase and myosin kinase.

Uterus:

Calcium increases the activity of the gravid uterus whereas it decreases the activity of the non-gravid uterus. During the premenstrual phase calcium is moralized from the tissue depot and plasma Ca++ level rises relatively, causing vagus stimulation; resulting in increased secretion of gastric juice. This causes vagus neurosis (asthma and urticaria) before and during menses. Calcium ions get mobilized from calcium depots during acidic condition; which leads to osteoporosis. Calcium lowers cellular metabolism. It decreases cell permeability by thickening the cell membrane. It reduces the haemorrhagic tendency by thickening and contraction of blood vessels. It reduces response to reflexes. It depresses thyroid hormone action.

Hypocalcemia:

Causes:

Pancreatitis, hypo raised serum organic phosphate, hypoproteinemia, and acute magnesemia, hypofunction of thyroid and germinal glands, hypoparathyroid, excess. Fluoride salts, high doses of steroids.

Clinical symptoms and signs:

- 1. It increases neuromuscular irritability and vagus irritability.
- 2. During low calcium level, cardiac muscle contracts slowly, QT interval increases, bradycardia leading to death in diastole.
- 3. Hypo function or cystic degeneration of ovary, non-rupture of graafian follicles, defective formation of corpus luteum resulting in absence of menses; or too early or too profuse menses.
- 4. Carpal and pedal spasm, anxiety, seizures, bronco-spasm.

Hypercalcemia:

Causes:

Excessive skeletal calcium causes release. Excessive absorption from the intestine. Inadequate excretion of calcium from kidney. Clinical symptoms and signs:

Fright, grief, disappointed love, malnutrition, imperfect ossification, suppression of eruption, wear and tear, over lifting or straining, fracture, exposure to cold moist wind, work, in water, delayed labor, artificial milk and snake poison.

It has a hydrogenoid constitution. Person is bulky, fleshy and flabby but without fitness. There is no oedema or retention of water underneath the skin. Skin is fair, waxy and shiny. Arsenic acts more promptly on non-vegetarians. It's just opposite to Nux Vom.

Chilly patient, There is internal chilliness and so the patient craves heat, excepting the outer head.

SOURCE OF CALCAREA ARSENICUM:

Calcarea ars. is prepared by mixing calcarea and Arsenic. So in Calcarea ars. we get few symptoms of Calcarea carb, and few symptoms of Arsenicum album, e.g. the person is chilly, fatty, ailments occur during climacteric period, mental depression, weak heart Palpitation on ascending, etc., are the symptoms of Calcarea; whereas mental anxiety, chill, great weakness, etc. are the symptoms of Arsenic. Dr. Hering proved this drug on his own body.

Calcarea carbonica:

Source: Calcarea carbonica is derived from the middle layer of oyster shells (Conchiolin) and occasionally from calcium carbonate deposits. This substance is rich in calcium, an essential mineral for bone health and various metabolic functions.

Historical use: Historically, calcium carbonate has been used in traditional medicine to treat bone disorders, digestive Issues, and skin conditions.

Arsenicum Album:

Source:

Arsenicum album is derived from arsenic trioxide, a compound naturally occurring in minerals such as arsenopyrite, realgar, and orpiment. Arsenic trioxide is purified and diluted to create the homeopathic remedy.

Historical use: Arsenic has a long history of use in traditional and ancient medicine for its powerful effects on the body, both beneficial and toxic. In the 18th and 19th centuries, it was used in small doses to treat conditions like syphilis, fevers, and chronic infections.

SYMPTOMS:

Infantile enlarged liver and spleen. Nephritis, with great sensitiveness in the kidney region. Complaints of drunkards after abstaining (Carbon sulph). Fleshy women at climacteric, slightest emotion causing palpitation. Dyspnæa, with feeble heart. Chilliness. Albuminuria. Dropsy. Affections of spleen and mesenteric glands. Hemoglobin and red corpuscles are low.

MIND-Anger, anxiety. Desire for company. Confusion, delusions, illusions. Great depression.

HEAD-Violent rush of blood to head with vertigo. Pain in head is better by lying on the painful side. Weekly headache. Benumbling headache mostly around the ears.

STOMACH-Region of stomach distended. Enlarged liver and spleen in children. Pancreatic disease; relieves burning pain in cancer of pancreas. Belching with saliva and beating of heart.

URINARY-Kidney region sensitive to pressure. Albuminuria, passes urine every hour. HEART-Constriction and pain in region of heart, suffocating feeling, palpitation, oppression and throbbing and pain in back extending to arms.

Pain and sinking in the region of the heart followed by spasms, Weakness, or vertigo, or more tary blindness. Convulsions with valvular disease of the heart. Evening and night aggravations are common. The patient is sensitive to cold-symptoms from ascending stairs. It has many burning pains like Arsenic. It has cured many cases of albuminuria in the early stages. It is a useful lack



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of vital heat. Aversion to the open air. General physical anxiety. Many remedy in chlorosis. Dropsy is a strong feature, as it is in Arsenicum and Calcarea. Complaints are worse from slight exertion; faintness, palpitation, dyspnoea and weakness come on. The left side of the body is most affected

The following mental symptoms are often a guide to its use. Anger and complaints from anger and vexation. Anxiety in evening, at night, in bed, and during a chill, and on waking. Apprehensiveness; about the future, about his salvation, at night. Inclined to criticise. Desire for company. Confusion of mind on waking. Inability to concentrate the mind. Delusions. Sees dead people, phantoms, images. Illusions of fancy. Sees visions of fire. Discontented. Excitable. Fear of death at night, of solitude, or insanity. worse at night, and on closing the eyes. Despair of recovery, of salvation. Becomes indifferent to pleasure. Insanity. Irresolution. Irritable. Lamenting Loathing of life; weary of life. Weakness of memory. Mischievous. Obu nate. Sensitivity is easily offended. Extreme restlessness, especially at night, tossing about in bed; during heat; and during menses. Extreme sadness in the evening, and during fever. Easily startled. Timidity. Weeping, at night.

There is violent rush of blood to the head with vertigo and generil spasm. It has caused and cured many chronic headaches. at night in bed. Burning heat in chest and pain in region of heart before epileptic convulsion. Orgasm of blood in the region of the heart. Throb-ling in the blood vessels, especially in head and back; it drives him out of bed. Pain in heart with palpitation. Angina pectoris. Grasping pain in heart. Palpitation, with heat of face. Palpitation from least excitement or exertion; worse evening and night. Every fourth heat of the pulse is omitted. Rapid pulse.

Violent headache between scapulæ and sacrum. Pain in back extends to the arms. Pain in the chest extends to the arms. Edema of the hands and feet. Weakness of lower limbs.



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Sleep is disturbed by violent dreams. Palpitation and suffocation. Latter part of the night was wakeful, and much sweat.

If this wonderful remedy is studied with the mind on Arsenicum and Calcarea, a broader knowledge will be gained. It needs further proof of its potencies.

4. CALCAREA ARSENICOSA BY- HC ALLEN:

Constitution:

Complaints of drunkards, after abstaining, craving for alcohol (Asar., Sul-ac.).

Complaints of fleshy women when approaching the menopause.

Mental Generals:

Great mental depression.

The slightest emotion causes palpitation of the heart (Lith-c.).

Cardio- vascular system:

Rush of blood to head and left chest (Aml-ns., Glon.).

Nervous system:

Epilepsies from valvular diseases of the heart.

Relation:

Compare: Con, Glon., Lith-c., Puls., Nux-v.

Follows well: After, Conium, in lymphatic, psoric or tuberculous persons.

5. CALCAREA ARSENICOSA FROM: THE SOUL OF REMEDIES BY-RAJAN SHANKARAN:

Calcarea arsenicosa is a mineral remedy of the cancer miasm. In Arsenicum there is a feeling: "I need people but I cannot trust them - they may rob me". The patient cannot trust anyone. In Calcium there is a need for security and support. Therefore, we see in Calcarea arsenicosa a person who feels insecure as well as mistrustful. In Calcarea arsenicosa the need for people is almost a dependence, and this along with the mistrust, makes him highly anxious and insecure. He feels: "I may be cheated, let down (mistrustful -Arsenicum) be the people on whom I depend for protection (Calcium)".

Calcarea arsenicosa is full of anxiety, extremely insecure. I had a case of a menopausal woman who came with the complaint of severe palpitation, which came on from the least anxiety, fright or bad news. She had a son and a daughter. The son went abroad and she got the feeling that he might never come back. All her complaints were worse when he left, especially after her husband fell ill.

She felt that her future source of support (in case her husband died) had become untrustworthy. This created extreme anxiety in her, and she would call her son over the phone every week. I gave her Calcarea arsenicosa on these features of mistrust and insecurity. Also Phatak's Materia Medica gives: "Complaints of fat women around the climacteric, when the least emotion causes palpitation".

Later, they may become extremely sad (Kent's Lesser Writings).

In the compensated state, Calcarea arsenicosa may be very careful and cautious. He is very independent.

Physical symptoms

- Chilly patient.
- Palpitation from least emotion.



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- Breathlessness on ascending.
- Desires soup.
