Playful rivalry, the honing of physical capability, the introduction of elements of strategy and chance, all define sport. Physical prowess is the primary defining feature that separates sports from games. The ability to perform physically well is a skill that may be honed via training and practise. The Paralympic Games or Paralympics, also known as the Games of the Paralympiad, is a periodic series of international multisport events involving athletes with a range of physical disabilities, including impaired muscle power (e.g. paraplegia and quadriplegia, muscular dystrophy, spina bifida), impaired passive range of movement, limb deficiency (e.g. amputation or Dysmelia), leg length difference, short stature, hypertonia, ataxia, athetosis, vision impairment and intellectual impairment. Since the 1988 Summer Olympics in Seoul, South Korea, the Paralympic Games have followed the Olympic Games as closely as possible. The International Paralympic Committee is responsible for organising all Paralympic Games (IPC).

From its humble beginnings as a 1948 reunion for British soldiers of World War II to one of the major international athletic events in the early 21st century, the Paralympics have gone a long way. The Paralympic Games were first proposed by doctor Antonio Maglio in Rome in 1960, and since then they have expanded to include 4520 competitors with disabilities from

163 National Paralympic Committees at the 2020 Summer Paralympics. While Paralympians and Olympic competitors from able-bodied backgrounds work hard to close the financing gap, it remains a significant obstacle in their pursuit of parity.

Although people with intellectual disabilities have been able to participate in the Paralympic Games since 1992, the Special Olympics World Games are organised separately and similarly to the Olympic Games, and the Deaflympics have been running since 1924 as an exclusive competition for deaf athletes.

Para athletes compete in a number of different divisions due to the vast range of impairments they face. There are ten different categories of disability that qualify for assistance. Impaired muscle power, impaired passive range of motion, limb absence, leg length discrepancy, short height, hypertonia, ataxia, athetosis, impaired eyesight, and impaired intelligence are some of the categories. These broad groups are then subdivided into even more specific groups.

2. INDIA AND PARALYMPIC GAMES

In 1968, at the Paralympic Games held in Tel Aviv, Israel, India participated for the first time. The Indian Olympic Committee sent a total of 10 participants to the Games, including 8 men and 2 women. Despite the fact that India did not bring home a single medal from the Games, the event served as a valuable introduction to the international scene for India's para-athletes.

India's first medal in the Paralympics was won at the 1972 Heidelberg Games in Germany, four years later. Gold in the men's 50-meter freestyle event went to para-swimmer MurlikantPetkar, who set a new world record with a timing of 37.331 seconds. However, India only won only one medal at the Games, putting them in 24th place overall out of the 42 competing countries.

Rich medal-haul in 1984 Paralympics after India made its Paralympic debut in 1972 and won their first gold medal. India did not compete in the 1976 or 1980 Games.

The Paralympic Summer Games of 1984 were held in two different cities. Wheelchair athletes with spinal cord injuries competed in Stoke Mandeville, United Kingdom, while those with cerebral palsy, amputees, and "others" competed at the Mitchel Athletic Complex and Hofstra University in Long Island, New York (others).

In order to secure a tie for 37th place with South Korea, the Indian delegation won a total of four medals, their best performance.

Joginder Singh Bedi's exceptional talent was a key factor in the success of the Indian team, by the way. Silver in the men's shot put and bronze in the discus and javelin throws were the results for Bedi. With his silver in the javelin, Bhimrao Kesarkar gave India four medals.

India's Paralympic fortunes changed drastically following their best ever showing in 1984. Indian teams had a hard time finishing in the top three between 1988 and 2000. However, the drought was broken in 2004 at the Games in Athens, when India won two medals—a gold and a silver—and placed 53rd overall.

In 2004, DevendraJhajharia took home gold in the javelin throw, and Rajinder Singh took home bronze in the powerlifting competition at 56 kg.

But in Beijing four years later, India came up empty.

Compared to their performances in 2008 and 2012, India stepped up their performance at the 2012 and 2016 Paralympics. India's silver medal in the men's high jump F42 event from London 2012 was won by HN Girisha. But that was the only medal India managed to win at that competition.

However, India's performance in Rio in 2016 was so impressive that they matched their record total of four medals. The four medals won by Indian Paralympians all came from athletics, which is one of their strongest disciplines.

Mariyappan Thangavelu won the high jump F42 event, Devendra Jhajharia won the javelin F46 event, and Deepa Malik won the shot put event and brought home the silver. Varun Singh Bhati took home bronze in the F42 high jump competition.

3. SUMIT ANTIL

Sumit Antil was born in Khewra, Sonipat, Haryana, India on July 6, 1998. Young Sumit desired a wrestling career and to join the Indian Army. In 2015, when he was 17 years old and heading home after training, his motorcycle was struck by a speeding truck. Due to the amputation of his left leg, he was unable to pursue his dream of becoming a wrestler. The Gosports Foundation supports Sumit through the Para Champions Programme. Antil was introduced to Para athletics by another Para athlete, Rajkumar, while he was doing his Bachelor of Commerce at Ramjas College of Delhi University.

Antil began training with Nitin Jaiswal in Delhi in 2017 and competed on multiple national and international venues. In 2019, Gosports admitted him to the Para Champions Programme after he began participating in javelin on the National circuit.

In 2019, at the World Para Athletics Grand Prix in Italy, he smashed the world record in the F64 category on his way to a silver medal in the Combined Event. He then won the silver medal in the 2019 World Para Athletics Championships in Dubai, breaking his own world record in the F64 division.

Antil won the javelin throw F64 gold medal with a world record throw of 68.55 metres at the 2020 Summer Paralympics on 30 August 2021.

His mother, Niramala Devi, and three sisters, Kiran, Sushila, and Renu, make up his family. His father, Ram Kumar, passed away when he was seven years old.

- He is proud of his nation, with which 197 (96%) of the mass population strongly agreed and 08 (4%) disagreed.








Figure 8 Sumit Antil's Personality






Figure 9 Sumit Antil as Javelin Thrower






Figure 10 Sumit Antil as a Role Model

- His skills for javelin Throw were supported by 123 (60%) of the mass, 54 (26%) of the








Figure 11 Sumit Antil as a Motivator
